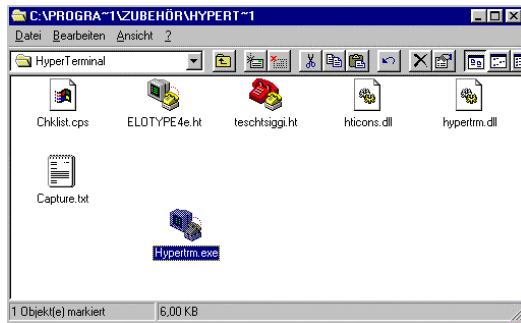


HYPERTERMINAL under Win95/98 for ELOTYPE 4/4E

1.



Connect the ELOTYPE with a free serial interface.
Following start the program 'HyperTerminal'

'Start-(button)' – program' – 'accessories' –
'Hyperterminal'
double click the icon: **HYPERTERM.EXE**

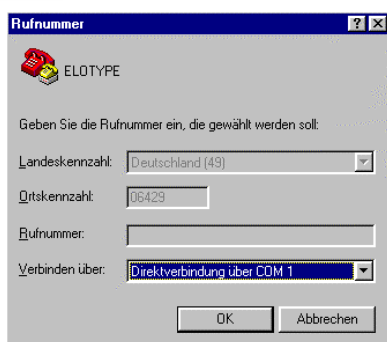

The following dialog box opens:
"Beschreibung der Verbindung"
(description of connection)

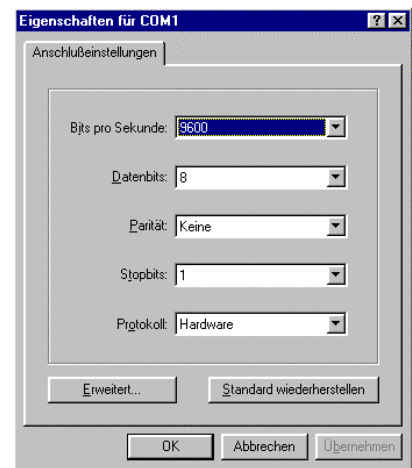
Please enter name.
e.g. ELOTYPE
Now press OK

Now the dialog box
"Rufnummer" (*call
number*) opens.
Under "Verbinden über"
'Direct connection via
COM1'
(*the number of COM-
port depends on the
free interface the
Elotype is connected
with*).
Now press OK

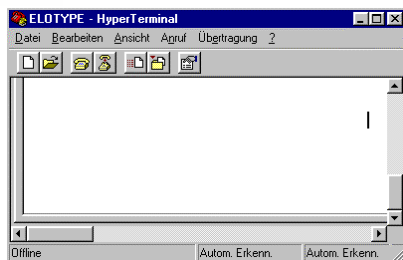

Now the following dialog box opens:
"Eigenschaften für COM1" (*properties of COM1*)
Please enter the correct data transmission rate of
ELOTYPE:

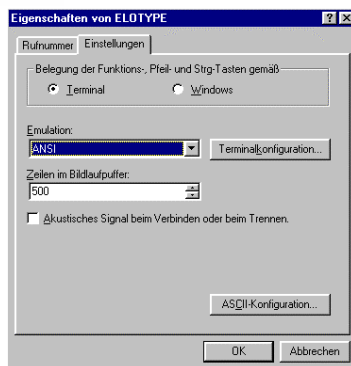
bits per sec. (baudrate)	= 9600
databits	= 8
parity	= no
stopbits	= 1
protocol	= hardware

Now the following window opens:
"ELOTYPE - HyperTerminal"
open the menu:
'Datei' - 'Eigenschaften' - 'Einstellungen'
(*File – properties – adjustment*)

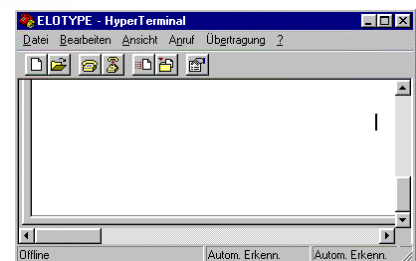
The following dialog box opens: "Eigenschaften von ELOTYP".
(*properties of ELOTYP*).

Change to register "Eigenschaften" (properties):

- click the radio button "Terminal"
- Select at Emulation "ANSI"
- Zeilen im Bildlaufpuffer (*lines in display or image buffer*): 500

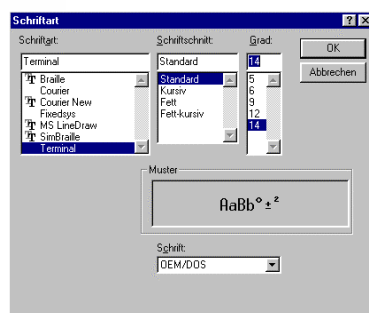
Now press OK

The following window opens again:
"ELOTYP - HyperTerminal"
open the Menu:
'Ansicht' - 'Schriftart'
(*view – font*)

Now the following dialog box opens:
"Schriftart" (*Font*).

Please select:

Schriftart (*font*): 'Terminal'
Schriftschnitt (*type face*): 'Standard'
Grad: (*font size*) you can adjust as you like. e.g. 14

Now press OK

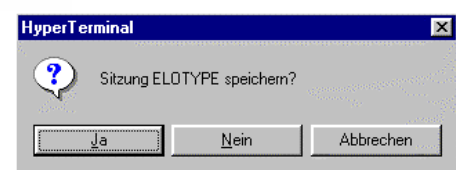
Now quit the program 'ELOTYP - HyperTerminal':

Open the menu:

'Datei – Beenden' (*File – Quit*) or press ALT + F4

Confirm the following message with JA (YES)!!! →
Sitzung ELOTYP speichern? (*Save ELOTYP session?*)

Following you will find the new entry 'ELOTYP.HT' in the folder 'Hyperterminal' .

Each time when you want to work with ELOTYP and HyperTerminal, please start the program by double clicking the new icon "ELOTYP.HT". You can also set a link of the icon to 'Desktop' or 'Startmenu'. For detail information please look at your Windows 95/98 manual.

Now all characters written on the connected ELOTYP, are displayed simultaneously on the screen of your PC.

NOTE: backspace movements of the embossing head and paper or line feed are not displayed or carried out on the screen.

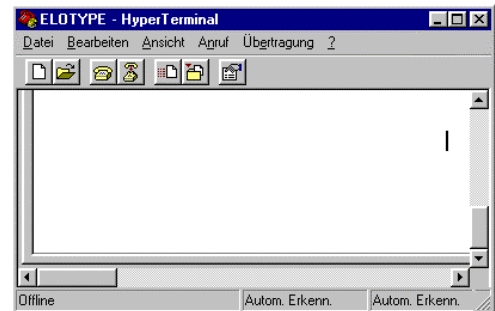
Recording (saving) text in a file with the program Hyperterminal:

While entering text on the ELOTYPÉ and displaying it on the screen, at the same time the text can also be stored in a file. These file can later be opened and edited by a text processor like WordPad.

Start text recording:

In window "ELOTYPÉ HyperTerminal"
open the menu:

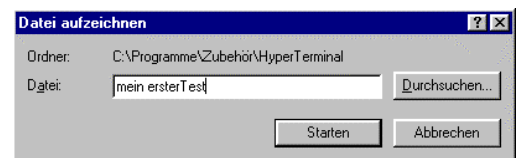
'Übertragung' – 'Text aufzeichnen ...'
(*transmission - text recording...>*)



Now the following dialog box opens: "Daten aufzeichnen" (*recording data*). Please enter the file name [field "Datei" (*file*):] <mein erster Test.txt>. This file will now be stored under the abovementioned folder 'Ordner:' (*folder*:). In case you want a new file stored in a different folder, please enter in the field 'Datei:' (*file*:) the complete path together with a new file name.

By means of the button 'Durchsuchen' (*browser*) you open a new dialog box: "Datei zum Aufzeichnen auswählen" (*Select file to record*). Here you are only able to select an already existing file in a different folder.

Note: This file will be overwritten by your new text.
Now press the button 'Starten' (*start*)



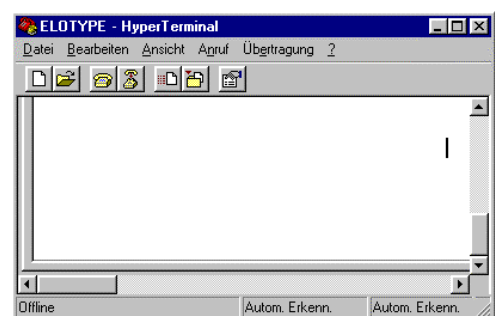
After this you are again in the window "ELOTYPÉ - HyperTerminal" and you can enter the text via the ELOTYPÉ. The text will be recorded (resp. saved) as long as you enter the stop recording command.

Stop text recording:

In the window "ELOTYPÉ - HyperTerminal"
open the menu:

'Übertragung' – 'Text aufzeichnen ...>' – **'Beenden'**
(*transmission - text recording...>* – **'quit'**)

Now you have finished saving text in a file.



Editing text with WordPad or WinWord:

Start WordPad or WinWord.

Open the menu: 'Datei' – 'Öffnen' (*file – open*)

In the dialog box "Öffnen" (*open*) select:

Dateityp: 'Textdokumente - MS-DOS-Format (*.txt)'
(*file type: textdocument – MS-DOS-format (*.txt)*)

Dateiname: <mein erster Test.txt>

(*file name: <mein erster Test.txt>*)
