



Writing Styles

Common (Perkins) Slate & Stylus



- 1. Press the **power button** to start the device. Make sure to charge it first.
- 2. Read the braille shown on the braille display (lower pad).



- 3. To write, pick up a **braille block** and push the dots up and down.
- 4. Place the blocks back on the upper pad and press the circle button to **check the answer**.
- To choose a new lesson, press the left arrow and circle button together for two seconds.

Tips

- To hear the word again,
 press circle button for 2 sec
- To switch between
 contracted & uncontracted braille,
 press both arrows together for 2 sec
- Use the arrow buttons to move to the next or previous word
- To go to settings, press all three buttons together for 2 sec








Pairing with the app

- 1. Download the Taptilo appusing the QR code.
- While Taptilo is on, open the app and select "Tap to connect your device."
- 3. From the pop-up, select your device. Make sure Bluetooth is turned on.
- To change connection settings, go to Options > Settings.

- 4. Check the answer on the app
